




Connect stove to Wi-Fi

This document will guide you through the entire process of installing the Aduro Pellet Stove app, creating an account, and connecting your stove to your Wi-Fi to enable remote operation of your Aduro pellet stove.


1. Open "Google Play" (Android) / "App Store" (iOS) and search for "Aduro Pellet Stove".
2. Press 'install' and open the app.




3. Press 'create an account'. Read and accept the general terms and conditions to continue. Register by entering your email and creating a password.



You can also choose to sign in with Google, Facebook, or Apple. However, if you want to control your stove from different devices, you must sign in with the same account.


Once your stove is connected to your account you can control it from any device by signing in with the login details of your account.

4. You will be asked to prove that you are not a robot. Follow the instructions and verify.

After verification, you will receive an email from support@wappsto.com asking you to confirm your email. Check your spam folder if you cannot find the email in your inbox.








5. Enter your email and password (login details of your newly created account) and sign in.

Other people in your household who may control your stove need to use the same login details on their device.

- Before adding your stove, make sure both **Bluetooth** and **Location** are enabled on your device. Press 'Add stove' or '+' and choose 'Connect stove to Wi-Fi' to start searching for a stove nearby.






If you choose to connect an ethernet cable, choose 'Use ethernet cable' instead and scan the QR code on the small label on the back of the stove. If you use an ethernet cable, jump directly to point 8.

7. Select your stove. Your stove is the one where the UUID (first picture beneath) matches the number on the label on the back of your stove.

Your stove is scanning for available Wi-Fi networks. Select your network or scan again/go to manual setup if your network does not appear on the list.


Enter your Wi-fi password and configure your Wi-Fi to continue.



- Please answer whether your chimney is equipped with an extractor fan before you continue.

Fill in your contact information. The email must be the one you used to sign in.

Once you have saved the information, your stove is connected to the Wi-Fi and can be controlled via the Aduro Pellet Stove App. Press 'Go to the stove' to access your stove.




